## Takeaways from this message.

There is no **BLINDNESS** on the part of God

✓ *Naboth's death was **UNJUST**, but it was not **UNNOTICED***

There is no **TIME FRAME** for the justice of God

✓ *All sin is **REPULSIVE** to God*

There is no **LIMIT** to the mercy of God

✓ *God's mercy is available to anyone who is willing to **RECEIVE** it*

8. *What have you learned through your personal time of Bible reading this week?*
